What is Safety Awareness Training?

Safety Awareness Training is a program presented by the Kelsey Smith Foundation, Inc. (KSF) to teach proactive techniques to keep you and/or your loved ones safe.

We concentrate on the emotional and mental aspects of safety, providing simple, common sense techniques that are easy to implement, and with practice become part of your daily routine.

Our training also tells the story of Kelsey Smith, who was abducted from a department store parking lot in Overland Park, KS, on June 2, 2007. Her body was recovered on June 6, 2007. She had been sexually assaulted and murdered.

- ✓ **MENTAL PREPAREDNESS: TO STAND UP FOR YOUR BELIEFS AND TO PROTECT YOURSELF**
- ✓ **AWARENESS: OF SURROUNDINGS, PEOPLE, PLACES & THINGS**
- ✓ **PHYSICAL PREPAREDNESS: THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING FIT AND READY TO ACT IF THE NEED ARISES**
- ✓ **SURVIVAL MENTALITY: THE MINDSET TO SURVIVE ANY SITUATION ENCOUNTERED**
